The civitas districts are current knowledge, Caerhun as the civitas capital for the Deceangli is not yet certain

Ingots listed are more than 8k and inscribed. Anything less than this is not listed. RIB 2404.26, 2404.27 and 2404.68 are not listed as being below this weight criteria. RIB 2404.67 only has a single letter V.
